### Recommended reading

Pre-planning your final arrangements is one of the kindest

things you can do for your loved ones. As a 'Preferred Partner', Arbor Memorial also sponsors publication of the 'You and Your

Survivors' workbook (available on-line at federalretirees.ca).

A good way to prep for meetings with your provincial candidates!

#### The report makes five recommendations:

- 1. Redesign the Shelter Aid for Elderly Renters program so that seniors' rents are 30% of their income and rent ceilings are adjusted to reflect the current reality of the rental market.
- 2. Increase the amount of BC Seniors Supplement and index the supplement to inflation consistent with other government income supports for seniors like CPP, OAS and GIS.
- 3. Eliminate the daily rate charge for home support.
- 4. Provide a shingles vaccine program at no cost to B.C. seniors.
- 5. Develop and implement a cross-government strategy and action plan for seniors (A "seniors' strategy"! Now there's an idea!)
