Pensioners' Dental Services Plan

Reminder: Canada Life takes over administration of the plan effective November 1st. Members of the PDSP should have already received notification from Canada Life that positive enrolment has been completed for you. But you are still asked to review your information within your PDSP account and update it as necessary, paying close attention to

- Your banking information
- Your mailing address
- Your eligible dependant(s) (if applicable)
- Your preferred name (if it differs from your legal name)
- Your preferred method of communication.

Important! For your security, **banking information** was not pulled from other sources. If you would like to receive your claim reimbursement directly into your **bank** account, sign into your PDSP Member Services account through My Canada Life at Work under your profile to provide your direct deposit information.

If you do not set up **banking information** as per the instructions above, any reimbursements for claims will be made by cheque and mailed to the address Canada Life currently has on file.
