DID YOU KNOW... Public Services and Procurement Canada announced <u>external access to MaPayeGC</u> launched on January 20 for all Government of Canada (GC) employees who:

- 1. are on leave without pay (including maternity, parental and long-term sick leave)
- 2. have left the public service (including recent retirees and students)
- 3. do not have access to a GC network due to the nature of their work.

<u>External access to MaPayeGC</u> will enable current and former federal government employees to securely access their pay and benefits outside the GC network.
